

Re-Entry Committee
Instruction & Technology Subcommittee Minutes
June 24, 2020
10:00 a.m.

The following committee members were present: Anne Uberti, Frank Purcaro, John Vouros, Tracy Galassi, Suzanne Hurley, Andrew San Angelo, Induk Song, Allyson Story.

Preliminary summary data from parent, staff and student surveys was shared with committee. Parent and student surveys are still open and a report will be presented once the surveys are closed.

Emerging themes from the survey results regarding what is needed in a distance learning plan more live interactions with teachers that includes direct instruction, consistency in the platforms used and the manner in which they are used, a more structured schedule to support accountability, and a balance of modalities for instruction (i.e. balancing screen time with paper and pencil tasks).

The committee decided to hold off on further action steps pending the release of Gov. Lamont's school reopening plan scheduled for release tomorrow, June 25th, and reconvene next Wednesday.

Next steps will focus on establishing 5-7 "non-negotiables" and then determining which actions steps will be required to achieve them.
